



NGAUS National Conference & Exhibition Milwaukee, Wisconsin August 22-25, 2025

The 147th NGAUS Conference will be held in Milwaukee from August 22 – 25, 2025. This year's theme is "America's National Guard: Affordable, Accessible, Lethal." Many conference events and industry exhibitions will be held at the Baird Convention Center at 400 W. Wisconsin Avenue. Transportation will be provided to off-site social events. IMPORTANT DEADLINES:

June 29 (Sunday) – Last date to reserve a room within Minnesota's room block at the Hilton Milwaukee City Center.

July 15 – Last date to cancel a paid conference registration, less a \$15 administrative fee.

After July 15 – All conference registration sales are final; no refunds will be processed.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FEE: All registrants must be NGAUS & NGAMN members to attend the conference. The registration fee is \$200 per person and includes access to the trade show, all mixers, the Governor's Reception, all luncheon events, and the All-States Dinner.

The golf tournaments, motorcycle ride, sport fishing, 5K fun run, and retiree luncheon are an extra fee. (See the registration form for pricing.)
